• All kindergarten students in the state of Texas are required to be assessed three times during the school year on their language and math skills.

These times are: Beginning of the Year (BOY)- September

Middle of the Year (MOY) - January End of the Year (EOY) - April.

Language skills that are assessed: first sounds, letter names, phonemic segmentation and nonsense words

Math skills that are assessed: counting, number identification, missing number, and quantity discrimination

We will discuss the results of these assessments at our first scheduled conference. Parent Conferences will be September 23-27. I will schedule conferences before and after school and also during the day from 9:30-10:00.

If your child does not know the letter names and sounds, you can help them by making them aware of letters that they see in their environment. A good time to "practice" these skills are when you read with your child each night. We will also be discussing friends, families, self-awareness, feelings, and emotions.
